I have watched this type of Options Trading evolve as more investors used weekly trading. The trading software I have developed adapted to the weeklies evolution. The software became simpler: It uses SPX for the weekly options My principle strategy for trading Weekly Index Options uses 2 sigma Condors: Short Calls 2 standard deviations above the market and the Long Calls the next strike price higher; Short Puts 2 standard deviations below the market and the Long Puts the next strike price lower. This is called 2 Sig Iron Condors. I have developed a tactic to make weekly profits in spite of the huge daily Up and Down movements in the SPX. SelfAdapSPXweeklyVLT is the name of my software which I use to generate monthly income. The software described in this book uses only SPX for the options because I discovered that when I used other underlying stocks or indices such as Google and SPY, SPX usually finished best.
